1. The People's Republic of Bangladesh received financing from the World Bank toward the cost of the Safety Net Systems for the Poorest (SNSP) Project and intends to apply part of the proceeds toward payments under the contract for procurement of Motor Vehicles under contract package# G-3.
2. The Project Director, Safety Net Systems for the Poorest Project- Component 2: Strengthening of MoDMR Program Administration (SMoDMRPA) under the Ministry of Disaster Management and Relief (MoDMR) now invites sealed bids from eligible bidders for supply of following motor vehicles and providing related services detailed below:

The Bidder's qualifications requirements include:

- (a) The Bidder must have been in business operation for manufacturing and/or supply of vehicles of similar type and category in Global market including Bangladesh for the last 10 (ten) years
 - (b) Average annual turnover of the Bidder, which shall not be less than worth in value equivalent to for, Lot-1: US\$ 5,400,000 , Lot-2: US\$ 450,000 and Lot-3: US\$ 1,000,000 for last five years.
 - (c) Demonstrated record of successful supply with after sale services under a single contract of value equivalent to for Lot-1: US\$ 1,800,000, Lot-2: US\$ 450,000 and Lot-3: US\$ 1,000,000 within past five years.
 - (d) The bidder must have present liquid asset and/or line of credit amounting not less than equivalent to US\$ 1,500,000 for Lot-1, US\$ 125,000 for Lot-2 and US\$ 300,000 for Lot-3.
 - (e) The local agent's relationship with the Principal Supplier/Manufacturer and all other evidence as stated in bid document.
3. Bidding will be conducted through the International Competitive Bidding (ICB) procedures as specified in the World Bank's *Guidelines: Procurement of Goods, Works and Non-Consulting Services under IBRD Loans and IDA Credits & Grants by World Bank Borrowers* (January 2011, edition-March 2013) and is open to all eligible bidders



as defined in the Procurement Guidelines. In addition, please refer to paragraphs 1.6 and 1.7 setting forth the World Bank's policy on conflict of interest.



Interested eligible bidders may obtain further information from the Project Director/ Procurement Specialist of SNSP-SMoDMRPA Project, 'Disaster Management Building', 92-93 Mohakhali C/A, Dhaka-1212, Bangladesh and inspect the bidding documents at the address given below from **10:00 Hours to 16:00 Hours** (Bangladesh Standard Time/GMT+6 Hrs) up to the date of **pre-bid meeting** to be held on **12 October, 2015**
5. A complete set of Bidding Documents in **English** may be purchased by interested bidders upon the submission of a written Application to the address below and upon payment of a non-refundable fee **Bangladesh Taka 7,800.00 or in US Dollar 100.00**. The method of payment will be Bank Draft/ Pay Order from a **scheduled Bank located in Dhaka for BDT and Cashier's Check or Bank Draft drawn on a local scheduled Bank in Dhaka**. The Bidding Documents will have to be collected locally by authorized representative only.
6. Bids must be delivered to the address below at or before **14:30 Hours, Bangladesh Standard Time on 04 November, 2015**. Electronic bidding will **NOT** be permitted. Late bids will be rejected. Bids will be opened in the presence of the bidders' designated representatives and anyone who choose to attend at the address below at **14:45 Hours, Bangladesh Standard Time on 04 November, 2015**.
7. All bids must be accompanied by a **Bid Security** of following amounts indicated against each lot in **Bangladesh Taka (BDT)** or in **US Dollar (US\$)**.
