Minutes of the 2nd PCMU (Project Coordination and Monitoring Unit) meeting of 2023-2024 financial year for "Disaster Risk Management Enhancement Project (Components 2 & 3) (DRMEP)" being

implemented by the Department of Disaster Management.

The Chairperson of the PCMU joined virtually. He welcomed all participants and started the meeting after his introduction. With the permission from the chair Mr. Subrata Paul Chowdhury, Project Director, DDM-PIU presented the agenda-wise topics in the meeting through power point presentation.

Agenda No. 1.: Confirming the previous meeting minutes of the 1st PCMU (2022-2023) held on 2nd May, 2023.

Discussion:

Project Director, DDM-PIU presented Minutes of the previous PCMU meeting held on 2nd May, 2023. The major decision taken on the meeting was:

PCMU unanimously recommended 06 (Six) nos. of DDM subprojects for PSC approval.

Project Director informed the meeting that 01 (one) subproject of Savar upazila under Dhaka district was not concurred by JICA.

Decision:

The minutes of the 1st PCMU meeting was discussed and confirmed excluding the subproject of Savar upazila under Dhaka district.

Agenda No. 2: Discussion & recommendation on Schemes, Drawing, Design & Estimate, Tender documents and Tender Advertisement of DDM subprojects during FY 2022-23 under Component-3, DRMEP.

Discussion:

Project Director, DDM-PIU informed the participants in the meeting that total 72 nos. of subprojects (52 nos. for DDM, 16 nos. for BWDB & 4 nos. for LGED) have been taken in FY 2020-2021 & FY 2021-2022. Total 16 nos of subprojects have been completed and the rest of the subprojects will be completed within the stipulated time.

Project Director then presented 04 (four) nos. of DDM subprojects from 03 Upazilas (Shantiganj, Pakundia & Kurigram Sadar) under 03 Districts (Sunamganj, Kishoreganj & Kurigram) as 2nd phase of FY 2023-24 through PowerPoint with photograph & videos. He mentioned that all the subprojects will be developed with necessary works by earth filling, culverts, gap filling, HBB works (where necessary) & turfing. The subprojects were selected on priority basis with the ones requiring essential works for previous flood impacts 2022. The Drawing, Design, Estimate & other documents of 04 (four) subprojects have been completed accordingly. The subprojects are mentioned below for discussion and recommendation by PCMU for PSC approval.

PCMU may kindly select and evaluate the proposed subprojects in accordance with the "Guideline and Manual for Operation of Disaster Recovery Fund" for JICA's concurrence and subsequent approval by the PSC.

He also informed the meeting that 5 nos. of DDM subprojects taken in FY-2023-2024 and approved by PSC. Tender has been floated and awarded NOA to the competent bidders. Works will be started very soon after performing necessary formalities.

Project Director, DDM-PIU informed the meeting that the tender of Package No.-DRMEP/KUR/Sada-Ulip/2020-2021, ID: 565977, Kurigram taken in FY- 2020-2021 has been cancelled as the contractor was not eager to continue the works. The said package in Sadar upazila under Kurigram district is now presented for recommendation of PCMU which needs to be tendered again for completion of the works undone.

The Chairperson requested the participants to give their valuable observations & comments on the proposed subprojects.

Md. Mostafizer Rahman, Deputy Project Director expressed his concern for the large number of people residing in the area of Shantiganj which are adversely affected during rainy season. If the subprojects selected it would huge benefit for transportation of people with commodities.

Project Director, DDM-PIU said that Deputy Project Director, Assistant Project Director, Roads & Bridge Engineer Mr. Abdus Sattar visited the proposed road site in Sunamganj & Kishoreganj District. They also discussed with concerned Union Parishad Chairman, local people & political leaders there. Local people requested to increase the road level as if becomes inundated.

Mr. Anisuzzaman Chowdhury, JICA representative said that the subprojects under Sunamganj district should be selected considering the local situation such environmental and ecological situation. He also suggested to select and take the packages which will be sustainable during flood surge in the haor area. He has strongly requested to avoid only earth filling road rehabilitation as the objective of the project is to ensure disaster resilience. Therefore all the sub projects should maintain the objective of the project. He also recommends revising the any proposal if it has decided to implement by only earth filling. In addition to these he has requested to project authority to check the completed sub projects whether these maintained the actual design drawings such as slope, compaction etc.

In reply, Mr. Halimur Rahman, Co-Team Leader, Consultant, DRMEP said that the above subprojects have been selected considering ecological diversity. It may be mentioned that 03 packages under Sunamganj district (Shantiganj & Jagannathpur upazila) concurred by JICA have been tendered earlier without HBB works due to ceiling barrier (30 – 70 million JPY). These packages may be developed with HBB after completing the present works depending on the availability of fund.

Mr. Wahiduzzaman, Project Director, LGED, DRMEP (Component 1) has requested to provide adequate drainage facilities for all sub-projects.

In reply Mr. Halimur Rahman, Co-Team Leader, Consultant, DRMEP informed that for all subprojects sufficient Box Culvert have been provided in the design for proper drainage facilities.

Mr. Abu Usuf Mohammad Rasal, Deputy Secretary, MoDMR informed that the subprojects in the haor area should be selected very carefully considering the local condition especially in the rainy season.

Mr. Mahbub Hasan Shahin, Deputy Chief, Planning Commission expressed his positive view for taking such type of subprojects in the haor area. It will certainly be beneficial to the local people.

Chairperson stated that subprojects should be selected very carefully before approval so that no problem raises while implementing the works.

Then he requested PD, DDM-PIU for implementation of the subprojects immediately after getting approval from PSC with necessary concurrence of JICA.

Decisions:

1. PCMU unanimously recommended 4 (four) nos. of DDM subprojects for PSC approval.

Agenda No. 3 : Miscellaneous:

Mr. Anisuzzaman Chowdhury has requested to submit the field visit reports whenever consultant or project authority investigate the sites. He also requested to submit the quarterly progress report in line with the observation of JICA. For the extension of the project period Mr. Chowdhury requested to Project Director to revise the Loan category that will be approved by ministry and concurred by JICA, following the submission of RDPP.

As there were no other agenda for discussion, the Chairperson thanked all participants and declared the meeting closed.
